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Important Information - Must be read before installing software.

 Before installing the CA3000 web interface, you must install IIS (Internet Information Services). IIS is a Microsoft product. It is on the XP Professional CD along with the Windows Server 2003 CD. It is recommended to have an IT associate install this before installing the CA3000 web interface (refer to Appendix A).

NOTE: IIS is a webserver. The CA3000Web interface is a web application. All web applications need a webserver to run on. The CA3000Web interface must be installed on the computer with IIS installed on it.

- The installation of the CA3000 web interface will vary whether you have Cardaccess3000 Version 2.6.19 or Version 2.6.19B and later. Version 2.6.19 has the web interface on the Program CD (Disk 1). Version 2.6.19B and later has the web interface on Disk 2.
- 3) The use of the web interface requires the CA3000 security key to have a 5 workstation license.
- 4) IIS (Internet Information Services) must be version 6.0.
- 5) Multiple web browsers work with the CA3000Web interface but it is recommended to use Internet Explorer.

Scope

This document contains information regarding the installation of the CA3000 web interface. As per the previous notes, Microsoft IIS must be installed on the computer before installing the CA3000 web interface.

InstallShield Wizard

If auto start is enabled on your system, the **CardAccess 3000 Version 2.6 Setup** screen will display after inserting the CA3000 CD in the CD-ROM drive (Refer to Figure 2). If Figure 2 displays, skip ahead to the steps following Figure 2. If nothing happens after inserting the CA3000 CD in the CD-ROM, continue with the next steps.

Note: If auto start is not enabled on your system, follow the steps below to execute the program.

- a. Click the **Start** menu on your PC, and then click on the **Run** menu option. You will see the 'Run' dialog box.
- In the 'Run' dialog box, click the white space of the open control, and type in D:\bin\launch.exe (Refer to Figure 1).

Note: D represents CD-ROM drive letter. This letter will be different depending on the drive letter of your CD-ROM.

Click on OK in the 'Run' dialog.

The CardAccess 3000 Version 2.6 setup screen will display (refer to Figure 2).



Click on the CardAccess Web Interface button.

The CA3000 web interface installation screens will display. Refer to figure 3 if the Visual C++ libraries are needed to be installed. If not, skip to figure 4 (Welcome to the CA3000Web Setup Wizard screen).

NOTE: The installation of the web interface requires certain components to be installed if they are not on the system already. If these are already installed on the computer, the installation process will skip to the CA3000Web Setup Wizard (figure 4).

Click on the **Install** button. The necessary components will be installed. After the installation of these components, The **Welcome to the CA3000Web Setup Wizard** screen will display (refer to Figure 4).

- 1) **192.168.1.215** is the IP address of the computer where IIS and the CA3000Web Interface is installed.
- 2) CA3000Web is the virtual directory on the computer with IIS installed on it.
- 3) Login.aspx is the name of the CA3000 web application.

Selecting a different SQL server and CardAccess 3000 database

After the install, use the **CARDACCESS 3000 Web Utilities** to select a different SQL server and a CA3000 database if needed (refer to figure 16 and 17). NOTE: The CardAccess3000Web installation pre-configures this information. In most cases you will not need to modify this.

APPENDIX A

IIS (Internet Information Services) Installation information

As previously noted, IIS is a Microsoft product. IIS is a webserver that is needed for web applications run on. Web applications are then accessed via a web browser (ex. Internet Explorer). It is highly recommended to have an IT associated who is familiar with web servers and web applications complete the installation prior to installing the CA3000Web interface. The screens below will point you in the right direction for the IIS installation of XP and Windows 2003.

NOTE: The Windows XP Professional or the Windows 2003 server CD is needed to install IIS.

IIS installation on XP Professional

(Refer to the following screens. The following screens are just for reference. Depending on different versions of Windows and different service packs, these screens could vary).

Go to Add/Remove program in Windows XP Profession. Click "Add/Remove Windows Components (refer to figure A1).

APPENDIX B

CA3000Web installation configurations

NOTE: The above CA3000Web installation procedure is always done on the computer with IIS installed on it.

The configuration of the CA3000 with the CA3000Web interface can vary. There are 4 components involved with this (IIS, CA3000Web interdace, CA3000 software and a web browser) Accessing the CA3000 via a web browser can be accomplished with one computer, two computers or three computers.

ONE COMPUTER EXAMPLE – (IN MOST CASES, THIS CONFIGURATION WOULD ONLY BE USED FOR TESTING, NOT FOR ACCESSING CA3000 REMOTELY VIA THE WEB)

In this configuration, IIS, CA3000Web interface, CA3000 application and the web browser would all be on one computer. You would access the CA3000Web interface by clicking the CA3000Web shortcut on the same computer.

TWO COMPUTER EXAMPLE -

In this configuration, IIS and the CA3000 application would be installed on the same computer. From a remote computer, you would access the CA3000 via a web browser.

THREE COMPUTER EXAMPLE -

In this configuration, IIS would be installed on one computer along with the CA3000web application. The second computer would have the CA3000 application installed on it. From a third computer, you would access the CA3000Web interface via a web browser.
