V2.6 Installation on a Workstation Procedure

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CA3000 Software Installation Procedure

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<u>Important Information</u> Must be read before installing software

- The installation of a CA3000 Workstation requires a valid V2.6 security key/license on the CA3000 Server/Host. The security key/license must support 5 or more workstations. If your security key displays "max workstations =1", no workstations are supported.
- 2. During the installation of a workstation, you will be prompted to enter the IP address of the CA3000 Server/Host. Before starting this installation, have the IP address ready to enter.
- 3. The Workstation you are installing communicates to the CA3000 Server/ Host via a network. It is very important to turn off all firewalls on the CA3000 Workstation and the CA3000 Host. To ensure proper communications to the CA3000 Server from the Workstation, you must be able to ping the CA3000 Server from the CA3000 Workstation by IP address and host name. If unable to ping by IP and host name, the CA3000 Workstation will not communicate properly with the host.
- 4. If you have any previous versions of CardAccess installed, un-install them prior to installing this software.

Scope

This document contains information regarding the installation of CA3000 V2.6 Workstation software. This procedure includes the installation of the EPI Badging3000. It is recommended to install the Badging3000 on a workstation. If you choose not to install the Badging3000 software during this installation, some of the following steps/screens may be different.

InstallShield Wizard

If auto start is enabled on your system, the **CardAccess 3000 Version 2.6 Setup** screen will display after inserting the CA3000 CD in the CD-ROM drive (refer to Figure 2). If Figure 2 displays, skip ahead to the steps following Figure 2. If nothing happens after inserting the CA3000 CD in the CD-ROM, continue with the next steps.

NOTE: If auto start is not enabled on your system, follow the steps below to execute the program.

- a. Click Start, Run. The 'Run' dialog opens.
- b. In the 'Run' dialog, type D:\bin\launch.exe in the Open field (refer to Figure 1).

NOTE: D represents CD-ROM drive letter. This letter may be different depending on the drive letter of your CD-ROM.

c. Click on OK in the 'Run' dialog.

The CardAccess 3000 Version 2.6 setup screen will display (refer to Figure 2).

Click on the Install CardAccess Workstation button.

Microsoft .NET Framework Installation

The installation of the CardAccess 3000 software requires **Microsoft** .**NET Framework 3.0**. If it is not already installed on the installation computer, the CA3000 installation process will install it (refer to figure 3). If it is already installed on the installation computer, the installation process will skip ahead to the **CardAccess 3000 Setup**.

A default path will display. If you are installing CardAccess 3000 to a different path, click the **Browse** button and select the path. **NOTE:** CardAccess 3000 must be installed under a Program Files folder. It is highly recommended to use the default path.

Click Next. The Select Additional CardAccess Components screen will display (refer to Figure 8).

Check the **Install CardAccess Badging 3000** option. **NOTE:** It is recommended to install Badging 3000 on a workstation, not a CardAccess 3000 host.

Click Next. The Current Settings screen will display (refer to Figure 9).

After reviewing and accepting the current settings, click **Next**. A progress bar will display while the CardAccess 3000 software is installing (refer to Figure 10).





After the completion of the CardAccess 3000 software installation, the **CardAccess 3000 Client Connection Utility** will display (refer to Figure 11).

Enter the **Server IP Address** (this is the IP address of the CardAccess 3000 server/host). The Server Port setting should be 9000 by default. Next, select a unique workstation number. Click **Save Settings**. The **Settings saved Successfully** popup will display (refer to Figure 12).

Click **OK** to close the popup in Figure 12. Click **Exit** to close the **CardAccess 3000 Client Connection Utility** screen. The **Badging 3000 Installation** popup will display (refer to Figure 13).

Click **Yes** to install the **Badging 3000** software. A popup will display prompting you to insert Disk 1 (CD-1) in before the computer reboots at the end of the installation (refer to Figure 14). The Badging 3000 installation occurs at the end of the installation, after the computer reboots. The files needed are on Disk 1 (CD-1).

SQL 2005 Client Tools Installation

Click **OK**. The **Setup Needs The Next Disk** screen will display. You will be prompted to insert Disk 2 (CD-2) (refer to Figure 15).

Remove Disk 1 (CD-1) from the CD tray, and insert Disk 2 (CD-2). **NOTE:** If a Windows dialog box displays (the dialog box will have four icons on it), click **Cancel**.

Click OK to start the installation of the SQL Express 2005 support files. During the installation of SQL Express 2005 support files, multiple setup screens will display along with Figure 16. This installation process will take a few minutes.

VERY IMPORTANT: If you selected to install the Badging 3000 software, you must insert Disk 1 (CD-1) before you click **Finish**.

Click Finish. The computer will restart.

If you didn't select to install the Badging 3000 software, the installation is complete after the computer reboots. If you inserted Disk 1 (CD-1) before the reboot, the **Welcome to the InstallShield Wizard for EPI Builder Run-Time 6** screen will display (refer to Figure 19).
