VERI-PHONE™ QUICK START GUIDE

WI844B-GEN 12/04

These instructions are abbreviated procedures for programming and wiring the Veri-Phone two-way voice module. For detailed instructions, refer to WI844 and WI1197.

PROGRAMMING THE VERI-PHONE

NOTE: When entering Programming Mode, entry key sequence must be completed within 10 seconds--otherwise place phone back on hook, pick up and start again.

To Program the Veri-Phone™, enter the following keystrokes on the TouchTone phone. Feedback beeps will confirm proper programming - (7 beeps indicate an invalid entry, re-enter field).

- To Enter the Default Program:

Note: The User Code is changed to the default factory settings only through Power-Up Programming

- To Change User Code:

Note: Dealer Programming timeout (indicated by 7 error beeps) occurs if the Veri-Phone™ does not receive Touch-Tone commands for more than 1 minute. If necessary, re-enter Dealer Programming.

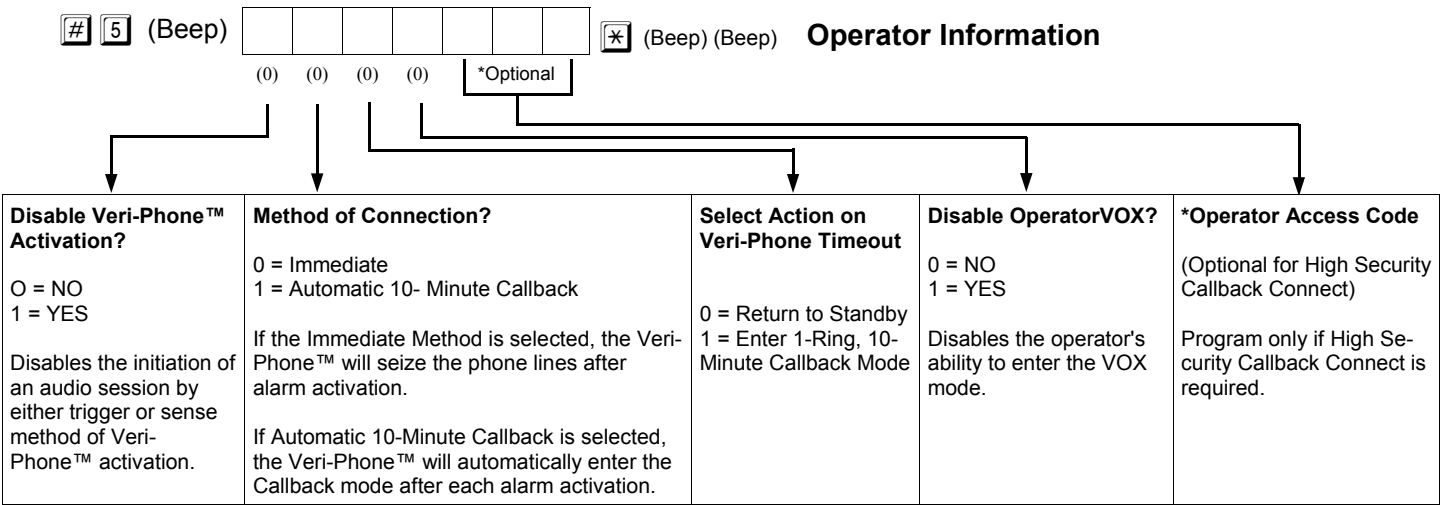

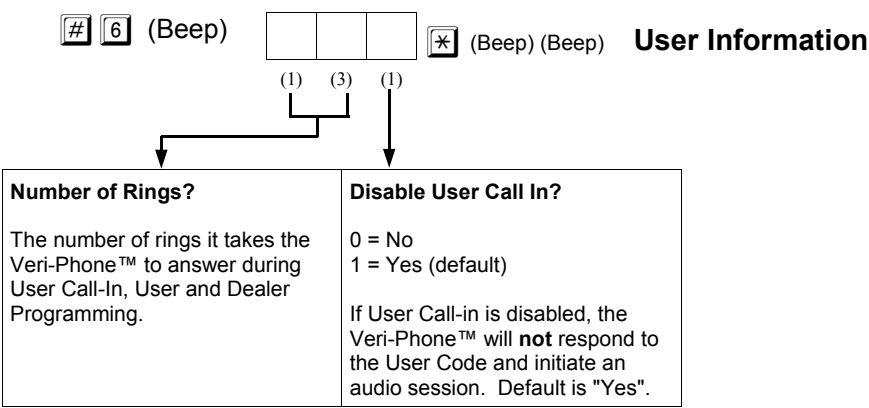
- To Enter the Operator Options:



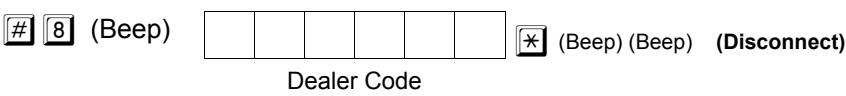
The first four options must be programmed whenever the #5 field is entered. If no Operator Access Code is desired, press [] after the fourth digit.

Note: Section 11.3, **Operation Using the SIA Command Set** (pages 25-26) is no longer valid and should be deleted.

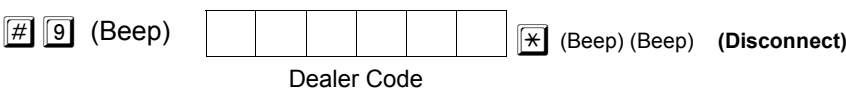

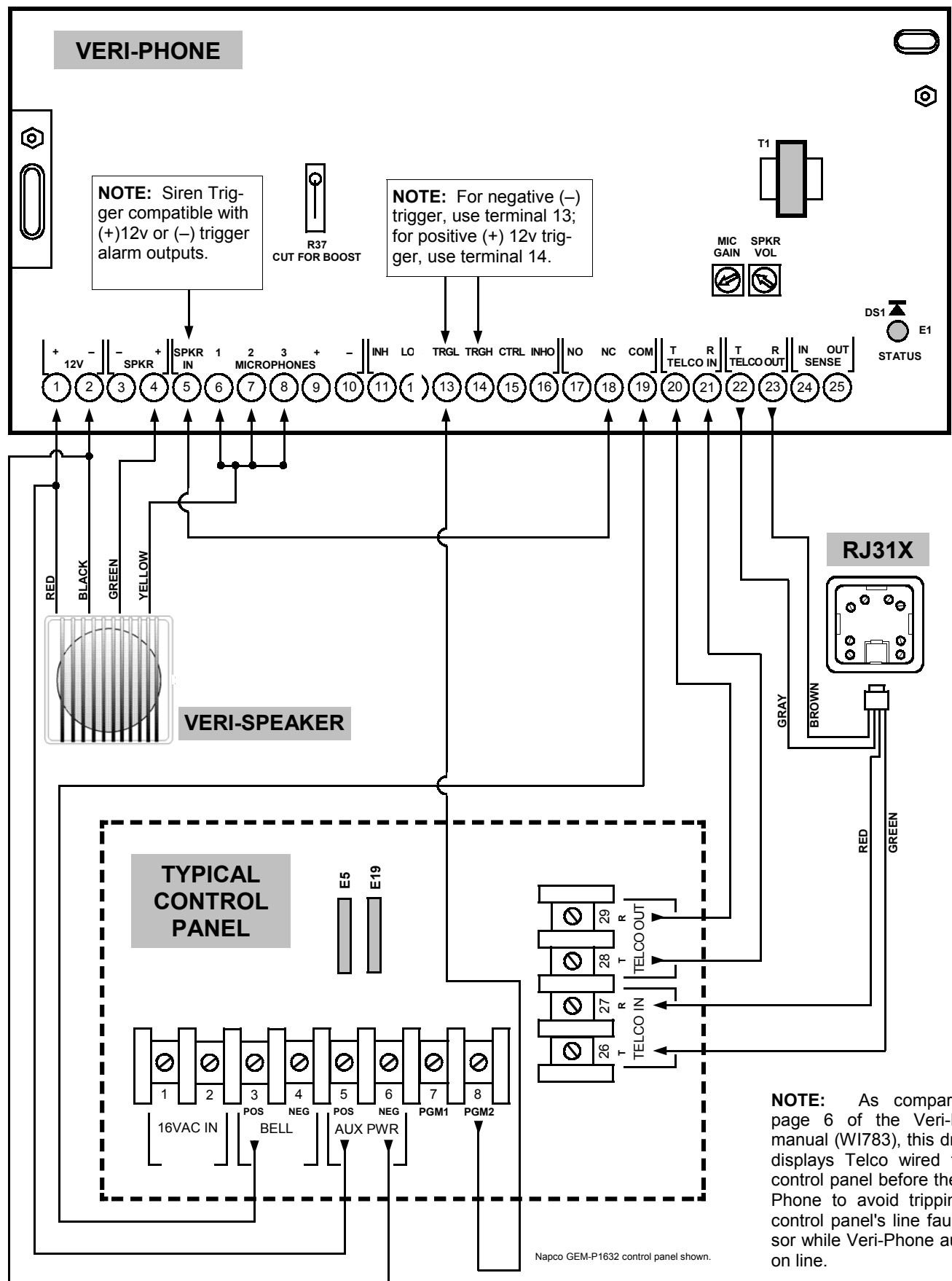


- To Exit Dealer Program Mode and Disable the Veri-Phone™ for 10 minutes to Download to the Control Panel:

PROGRAM THE PANEL FOR VERI-PHONE

1. **Enable PGM2 to trigger Veri-Phone.** At address 0722, press 2 and 3.
